Dear Believer:

I am excited. How many times can someone say that and not run out of reasons to be excited? Frankly, if you are looking at God and not your problem, you can say it forever. God is never out of new truly creative ideas, plans, and works. It is the ultimate thrill ride to just hang on to God and go where He is going. Recently I was speaking with an intercessor who has prayed for Corpus Christi for many years now. This intercessor prayed and prayed, but could not see or sense any movement. But as the old praise song says, "It's different now." Now the individual is telling me that it is as though they are strapped on the bull at the rodeo waiting for the gate to open, wondering if they can hang on for what God has planned.

We have shared with many people about meeting intercessors and other people of prayer that God has brought here to pray for the area. Some were brought kicking and screaming because of the heavy spiritual atmosphere. The heaviness has been broken. At the most recent Pastors Prayer Breakfast we were told of a man who interviews people who have come to our city. He often asks them why they have come to Corpus Christi. Many of them have answered that they just have a sense that something great is going to happen here and they want to be part of it. Considering the past heaviness, this is a wonderful testimony of the work of God in our city. It seems that God may be drawing people here.

Also shared at the breakfast was that one of the intercessors praying for our city recently saw an angel standing in the city. They asked the Lord about it and the Lord said the name of the angel was Hope. This again indicates a powerful shift in the spiritual atmosphere of Corpus Christi. Hopelessness has often been the sense of many coming here, but God has changed that and instead we are earnestly expecting a move of God in Corpus Christi.

Since Christmas I have heard that people from other areas are hearing what the Lord is doing among the leadership in Corpus Christi. They are asking how it can happen in their city. Put in the simplest terms, GOD IS MOVING IN CORPUS CHRISTI and people elsewhere are beginning to know it.

Keep praying! Keep doing what He says when He says it. Remember us in your prayers and giving.
