All these things are happening along with literal signs in the very heavens. What does it all mean?

Things are tightening up in the spiritual realm. We will assuredly be doing things differently. God has broken spiritual stagnation and strongholds around us and while the world and its systems are being turned upside down, our feet are firmly planted. We are becoming unmovable. It is as though a tornado is going on around us with things flying all over, but it is not really affecting us. Wherever something is vibrating or shaking, it is God dealing with something in our lives. We are being laid bare; when we think there is nothing left and we are waiting on the Lord to restore, even more is taken away, but the result is trimming, pruning preparation for battle. Where are the Jeremiah, the Isaiah, and the Daniel voices who speak to governments? Where are the Nathan and Gad voices who speak to specific leaders? Where is the true prophetic voice of the Church to engage the culture and structure of the nations, proclaim the Word of salvation through the Blood of Christ, and declare the coming of the one who bears the name Faithful and True? Where is the voice of rulership in the spiritual realm that will silence the voices of strife, complaint, and condemnation?

Let us pray as we seek communion with the Lord and each other that we might defeat the anarchy that is growing. Also let us give honor where honor is due. Let us respect the Blood which has purchased us all. Let us, in the unity of the spirit and the bond of peace, call forth the Prophetic Voice of the Church. It is time for being still rather than standing still; time to go forward unshakably in boldness; and time to look up while reaching out. We are here for such a time as this.
