Dear Believer:

Our Lord is doing wonderful things in the Monthly Pastors' Prayer Breakfast here in Corpus Christi. This month the question raised for input and discussion was: "What is God doing among us?" The responses as arranged below are in paragraph form.

As we spoke of the Lord giving a time of a flow of clarity through every denominational group, we heard from those present that there is growing understanding of kingdom events and an increased desire to seek the Lord because He is God. It is time to speak of what He is doing not what He is going to do. In that vein Pastor Don Leavell specifically shared three things: 1) The Lord has gathered us for the gathering storm and it is not just our idea of revival. It is a lot bigger than that. **We must know why God is doing what He is doing in our city and region.** 2) Each of us is important to God's plan in the earth. We need to spend time with the Lord until that is understood. 3) We need to be able to identify and articulate what God is doing.

From others present at the breakfast we heard that God is positioning us for Kingdom results and is doing it in such a manner that we will know the priorities that are His. He is building a network for His purpose. God's network includes the church, as well as governmental leaders and a business community that is befriending what God is doing. The Lord is consummating us as Biblical prophesy is being fulfilled. He is bringing us to a place of being a strong, unified body. We must understand where we are in God's timetable and positionally in the Body. The Lord is bringing us to truly love each other and is causing us to become sober and vigilant. God is setting His people apart and we are to set ourselves apart for His purposes. All the tribes are being gathered together and answering the call to be holy. The Lord is expanding our realms of influence. He is being very strategic in how He is enlarging our tents. He is opening our eyes to the prophetic word. The world will see catastrophic events; we will be in the ark. Jesus is bringing us to readiness so that having done all, we may stand. He is calling us to get on board (the ark); travel light; be true to the call. He is preparing us so that in the difficulty the coming storms bring, we are not afraid; we will help each other. He is saying to us Revelation 3:21 – Let he that has an ear hear what the Spirit is saying to the churches. He desires a Joshua kind of answer; as for me and my house we will serve the Lord; Love; Serve. The Father is bringing us to understand our true value on earth is only as spiritual beings.

Pastor Betty Vestal related the following: "I see a hook in the spirit." The interpretation which was then shared was: "The supernatural defies circumstances. The greatest challenge we have is believing the word instead of our circumstances. There is an invisible hook drawing people forth just as Jesus told Peter to go get the tax money. The requirement is unquestionable obedience to the written word and the supernatural word. Those who obey will be used mightily in this last hour; those who do not obey will be swept aside."

The above statement is even more interesting because at a recent meeting intercessory leaders independently came to understand many problems experienced by the Body come from a lack of trust in the Lord and unbelief. My question for our meditation and prayer is, "Why do we sell our God so short?" As we meditate on the things that leaders of this region are hearing from the Lord and seeing Him do, let us pray, "Lord I believe. Help my unbelief. Father show me how to deal with all that keeps me from intimacy with you. God do whatever is necessary to remove these things from us."
